House and Challenge matches continue this week and next. Parents are most welcome to come along and offer their support.

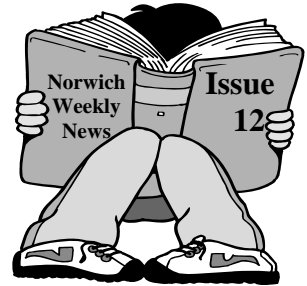
