## HOMESTAY ACCOMMODATION

Joining us in the Sixth Form at Year 12, our international pupils live with local British host families and are therefore able to become fully immersed in the English language and culture. This homestay scheme has proven to be enormously successful and popular with international pupils, who value the support, knowledge and independence that it offers.

The welfare, happiness and safety of our international pupils is absolutely paramount. Gabbitas Education run and manage our

homestay scheme and act as guardians for our international pupils; as one of the most esteemed and respected educational consultancies in the world, we feel that Gabbitas is perfectly placed to place our pupils with trusted, compassionate and experienced families.




## ABOUT NORWICH

With an international airport and rail links to London in under two hours, Norwich has excellent transport links.




## CASE STUDIES

If applying through an agency, the test must be taken under controlled conditions at the agency office. If applying directly, the test must be taken under controlled conditions at your current school wherever possible.</p> <p>To move an application forward, you must get an average score within the range B2-C1.</p>
<p><b>4</b> Examination &amp; Interview</p> <p>If your Password result and academic information suggest that you are a suitable candidate, you will be invited to sit selected entrance examinations and an interview will be arranged (in person or via Skype).</p>	<p><b>5</b> Offer</p> <p>If you are successful, an unconditional offer will be made. In order to accept this offer, you will have provided us with:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• school joining documents;</li> <li>• a registration fee of £350 (non-refundable);</li> <li>• an acceptance deposit of £550 (refundable after departure from the course);</li> <li>• first term's fees in advance, to reach us in May of the year a pupil joins the school (Homestay accommodation and fee collection will be arranged by Gabbitas).</li> </ul>	<p><b>6</b> Visa</p> <p>Once all of the required documentation is received, we will issue a Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies (CAS) in support of your Tier 4 Visa application. It is the parental responsibility to ensure all UKVI requirements are met.</p> <p>British passport holders should make their citizenship known early in the process.</p>
