Joining us in the Sixth Form for Year 12, our international pupils live with local British host families and become fully immersed in English language and British culture. An external guardianship runs and manages our homestay scheme, acting as guardians for our international pupils. 

If you have sat UKISET. email results to admissions as proof of your proficiency in English.

Pupils who have not sat UKISET will be required to sit the online Password English test, instructions for which will be communicated by the Admissions Team.

Examinations must be taken under controlled conditions in the agent's office or your current school. Pupils are expected to have a minimum score of 5.5 on the CEFR.

Examination & Interview

If your English result and academic information suggest that you are a suitable candidate, vou will be invited to sit selected entrance examinations.

An interview will be arranged to discuss subject choices and give vou a chance to discover more about the school.

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Offer

Once the application process is complete, we will endeavour to make a decision within 10 days. If you are successful, an unconditional offer will be made. In order to accept this offer, you will need to provide:

- School acceptance documents:
- an acceptance deposit of £550 (refundable after departure from the course);
- · First term's fees in advance of £8,000

(Homestay accommodation and fee collection will be arranged separately).

Once all of the required documentation is received. we will issue a Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies (CAS) in support of your Student Visa application around June before your child comes to the UK. It is the parental responsibility to ensure all UKVI requirements are met.

British passport holders should make their citizenship known early in the process.
