Norwich School's Choral Society was founded in 1983 and its membership is open to all keen singers in the city, including parents and friends of the school. There are no auditions; experience is desirable, but not obligatory. Each year, the Choral Society joins forces with the Norwich School's Chapel Choir to perform in St Andrew's Hall. Repertoire features the cornerstones of the choral canon, as well as some lesser known works. Recent concerts have included Haydn's Lord Nelson Mass; settings of the Requiem by Fauré and Rutter; Handel's Messiah, as well as opera choruses and songs from the shows.

For their 2019 concert, the Choral Society will, for the third time, join forces with the internationally renowned London Mozart Players to perform works by Mozart, Brahms and Rutter. The concert will also include a performance of Bruch's Kol Nidrei, which will feature Norwich School pupil Adam Possener as the viola soloist.

The Choral Society is always keen to welcome new singers. Weekly rehearsals take place on Wednesday evenings 5.45-7.00pm between September and March each year. Those interested in joining a friendly, enthusiastic and hard-working choir should contact music@norwich-school.org.uk
